1. The petitioners are seeking directions to be given to the official respondents to give seven days advance notice in view of the parameters/guidelines laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court in *Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar : 2014(3) RCR (Criminal) 527*. In addition, it has been submitted that a representation (Annexure P-1) dated 16.02.2025 was also given to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, however, it had been in vain as the petitioner was continuously being harassed at the hands of the private respondents, who wield considerable influence.

After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if appropriate directions are issued to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Panchkula, to look into the representation dated 16.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) and take appropriate steps at the earliest.
