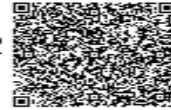

1. The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 483 Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, with a prayer to grant regular bail to him in case FIR No.41 dated 22.04.2024, registered under Sections 307, 323, 326, 324, 201, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Bhikhiwind, District Tarn Taran.
2. Mr. Munish Raj Chaudhary, Advocate has put in appearance and filed Power of Attorney on behalf of the complainant and the same is taken on record.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the parties in the present case are closely related to each other and have already entered into a



compromise vide compromise deed dated 23.07.2024 (Annexure P-2) and even the complainant, namely, Jashandeep Singh has sworn an affidavit dated 08.08.2024 (Annexure P-4) in favour of the present petitioner. He further contends that even as per the prosecution version, the petitioner had given a single blow with datar on the left leg below the knee of the complainant. However, the injured has already been discharged from the hospital. Still further, challan against the petitioner has already been presented before the competent Court and since the matter has been settled between the parties, the chances of conviction are bleak.

4. On the other hand, learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant have vehemently opposed the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner on the ground that serious allegations have been levelled against the present petitioner and he does not deserve the concession of bail by this Court.

5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

6. The petitioner was arrested in the present case on 17.07.2024 and is in custody for the last about 06 months. Even, similarly placed co-accused Baldev Singh @ Joban Singh @ Teedi has already been granted concession of bail by this Court in CRM-M-60868-2024 vide order dated 09.01.2025. Moreover, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties, who are closely related to each other.

7. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to his



furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate/Chief Judicial Magistrate, concerned
