**VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J.** (Oral)

1. Petitioner has assailed the order dated 30.08.2025 passed by learned Additional District Judge, Ludhiana, whereby the application filed by the petitioner for providing one single opportunity to defendants to cross-examine PW1-Rajinder Singh. The case history shows that the civil suit is pending for more than 10 years and PW1-Rajinder Singh appeared as witness. He was not cross-examined on number of occasions and was partly examined in 7 effective opportunities granted by the Court and thereafter, further cross-examination of the PW1-Rajinder Singh was declined vide the impugned order.

2. Considering all the facts and circumstances, there is no illegality or perversity in the order passed by learned Commercial Court but considering the fact that party should be afforded an opportunity to contest the cases on merits and there is some fault with the petitioner as petitioner failed to cross-examine the witness on seven effective opportunities, but considering all the facts and circumstances, one effective opportunity is granted to the petitioner to cross-examine PW1-Rajinder Singh subject to payment of Rs.50,000/-. Out of the amount of Rs.50,000/-, Rs.20,000/- be deposited in the account maintained by



Punjab State Legal Services Authority for help of flood victims and Rs.30,000/- be paid to respondent and the trial Court shall adjourn the case for one week granting opportunity to the petitioner/defendant to cross-examine PW1-Rajinder Singh.

3. In the light of above, the present revision petition is disposed of, so also the pending miscellaneous applications, if any.
