**RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J. (ORAL)**

Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.96 dated 13.08.2024, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 3(5), 351(2) of BNS, 2023 (Section 118(2) of BNS was added later on), registered at Police Station Sultanwind, District Amritsar.

Vide order dated 23.01.2025, while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in pursuance to the order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute.

However, learned counsel for the complainant has opposed the prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Avtar Singh has

stated that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, interim order dated 23.01.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of BNSS, 2023. Petition stands allowed.
