1. Respondent, who is present in person assures that the needful exercise towards execution of warrants of possession in terms of partition proceedings/determination has been scheduled for 07.03.2025 and shall be concluded immediately.

2. In view thereof, no cause survives in the present petition, as such, the same is disposed of.

3. However, in case the needful is not done, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring /concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application, if any.
