1. Prayer in the petition is for initiating proceedings against the respondents for intentional and willful defiance of order, Annexure P/1, dated 03.11.2021, in CWP-20535-2021.

2. At the outset, learned Addl. AG, Punjab, on telephonic instructions from the respondent states that order Annexure P/1 dated 03.11.2021, in CWP-20535-2021, would be complied with and appropriate orders in respect thereto would be passed by 5:00 p.m. on 06.06.2022 and the same would be implemented within a period of one week thereafter.

3. The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner, who states that in the circumstances, the petitioner does not press the instant petition and may be permitted to withdraw the same, at this stage.

4. In view of the statement of learned Addl. AG, Punjab, as well as statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant petition is *disposed of* as not calling for any action against the respondent under the

Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, while directing the respondents to ensure adherence to the assurance given through the learned Addl. AG, Punjab, within the stipulated period of time. Needless to mention, the petitioner would be at liberty to move an application for revival of the contempt petition in the eventuality of the undertaking/assurance held out by the learned Addl. AG, Punjab, not being complied with within the stipulated period of time.
