Prayer in this 2nd petition filed under Section 483 of the BNSS, 2023, is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.30 dated 29.04.2024 registered under Sections 21 and 22 of the NDPS Act at Police Station Aur, District S.B.S. Nagar, Punjab.

Custody Certificate filed in the Court is taken on record.

Learned State counsel, at the very outset, on instructions from ASI Nirmal Singh, submits that the prosecution has examined all the witnesses as out of 10 PWs, 07 PWs already stands examined and 03 PWs have been given up and the case before the learned trial Court is now fixed for 03.05.2025 for recording the statement of the petitioner under Section 313 Cr.P.C. and the 1st petition filed by the petitioner seeking regular bail was dismissed as withdrawn only on 17.12.2024 and the petitioner is involved in 07 more cases registered under the provisions of the NDPS Act.

In view of the above, no ground for grant of regular bail to the petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
