MAIN CASE

1. Learned counsel for respondent no. 2-Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh has filed an affidavit in CM-148 of 2025, stating that in the present case, the encroachments made by the motor mechanics have since been more or less cleared.
2. Certain motor mechanics have filed CM-140 of 2025, CM-141 of 2025 and CM-142 of 2025, seeking impleadment in the present petition.

3. The prayer for impleadment is rejected. However, in case, the motor mechanics are aggrieved by the removal of encroachments undertaken by the Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh, they are free to approach the appropriate Forum, in accordance with law.
