1. Prayer in the present petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, for alleged willful violation of the order dated 05.08.2024 (Annexure P-1), passed in CWP-18381-2024.

2. Compliance affidavit dated 03.12.2024 of the respondent, already filed, is taken on record. Registry to tag the same at appropriate place.

3. Learned counsel appearing for the respondent contends that the directions issued by this Court vide order dated 05.08.2024 stands complied with, as the respondent-Corporation has approved the payment of Rs.23,09,878/- in favour of the petitioner and the same has been credited to the account of the petitioner through RTGS on 12.11.2024. However, a sum of Rs.3,78,274/- has been withheld as security up to the DLP period, i.e. 20.10.2025, as per the terms & conditions of the work order.
