1. The present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.306 dated 11.11.2024 under Sections 74, 351 (2) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar.

2. After arguing vehemently on the merits of the case, learned counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender and seek concession of regular bail, however prays that direction be issued to decide his regular bail within three working days. He, thus, prays for withdrawal of the present petition with aforesaid direction.

3. In light of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the

petitioner to surrender within 07 days from today and in case, he applies for grant of regular bail, the same shall be decided expeditiously, preferably within a period of 10 working days.

4. It is made clear that this order shall not be considered as any direction for grant of regular bail to the petitioner and the same shall be decided on its own merits, in accordance with law, without being influenced by this order.
