1. The instant petitions have been filed under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in case FIR No.551, dated 17.10.2024, under Sections 121(1), 126, 132, 190, 191, 191(3), 221, 351(3) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023, registered at Police Station Sadar Thanesar, District Kurukshetra (Annexure P-1).

2. On 07.11.2024, the petitioner (in CRM-M-55318-2024) had been granted interim anticipatory bail with direction to join investigation, and the relevant part of the said order reads as under: -



*“Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that although the allegations are that 5-6 persons including the petitioner had assaulted the complainant, who is working as Assistant Sub Inspector (ASI) in Haryana Police, but there is no such evidence to show that the complainant had sustained any injury much less any grievous injury.”*

3. The petitioner (in CRM-M-61923-2024) was granted the concession of interim bail in the same terms as in CRM-M-55318-2024, vide order dated 10.12.2024.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners, at the outset, submits that both the petitioners have complied with the order dated 07.11.2024 and 10.12.2024 respectively, and joined investigation.

5. Learned State counsel, on instructions, also does not dispute the factum of the petitioners having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioners are not required for further investigation, much less for their custodial interrogation.

6. In view of the above, the instant petitions are disposed of, and interim order dated 07.11.2024 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) BNSS.
