1. The present petition has been filed alleging violation of order dated 06.02.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed in CWP-3302-2024 titled as 'Jugati Ram vs. State of Haryana and others' whereby the petition was disposed of on the statement made by learned counsel for the State that "*...the pending representation, dated 25.9.2024, will be decided by the second respondent/Director Elementary Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.*" It was further directed that "*...In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of Rs.50,000/- to the petitioner.*"

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the State submits that the necessary compliance of the order dated 06.02.2025, has been made as, the Sanction Order dated 01.09.2025 has been passed.

3. A copy of the Sanction Order dated 01.09.2025, handed over in Court by learned counsel for the State is taken on record. A copy



thereof, has been supplied to learned counsel for the petitioner, who submits that in view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition and the same may be disposed of.

4. Heard.

5. In view of the facts noted above, no further direction is required to be passed; and the present petition is hereby **disposed of**.
