**ASHWANI KUMAR MISHRA, J. (ORAL)**

1. Learned Single Judge has dismissed the writ petition filed by the appellant after noticing the fact that the correct category of the appellant is Unreserved/General Category and the appellant has secured 27.21 marks whereas cut-off in the General Category is 64.50. It appears that initially, the appellant had claimed status of a candidate belonging to Dependent Freedom Fighter (*DFF*) but it is undisputed that the appellant does not fall in such category and actually falls in Unreserved Category.

2. Once it is undisputed that the appellant falls in the Unreserved Category and has not secured marks above the cut-off in the respective category denial of relief to the appellant merits no interference.

3. Accordingly, the instant appeal is dismissed.

4. Pending applications, if any, also stand disposed of.
