1. The petitioner is seeking the concession of anticipatory bail, under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023, in case FIR No.150, dated 08.10.2024, under Sections 305, 331(3) of BNS, 2023, registered at Police Station City Khanna, District Khanna.

2. On the last date of hearing i.e. 04.06.2025, while noticing the following submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner, a coordinate Bench of this Court had granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner and asked him to join investigation:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner and his son have been entangled in the present FIR by the complainant without any genesis. There is unwanted delay of six days and there is nothing coming forth as what was the prima facie evidence against the petitioner, which led to lodging of the FIR, in which they have been named. The petitioner submits that he has clean antecedents.”

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of order dated 04.06.2025, petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Mohinder Singh, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

5. On a pointed query to the learned State counsel, he, on instructions, has not disputed that the petitioner has no previous criminal antecedents.

6. In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 04.06.2025, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
