SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 30.05.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-11836-2024.
2. The relevant portion of order dated 30.05.2024 passed by this Court is reproduced as under:-

“7. Though this Court would have deemed it fit and appropriate to initiate proceedings for contempt against the Sarpanch of the decree holder-Gram Panchayat concerned but since the Sarpanch of the Gram Panchayat concerned namely Sh. Ramesh Kumar is present in the Court today and apologizes for his errant conduct. Resultantly, the said tendered unconditional apology is accepted. Consequently, this Court does not proceed to issue any contempt notice upon him.

8. The execution petition be ensured to be filed within two days by the Sarpanch of the decree holder -Gram Panchayat concerned and

subsequently the learned executing court shall proceed to issue warrants of possession, and, after successful and complete execution of the warrants of possession being made, thereupon, the Assistant Collector shall record such a satisfaction.

9. Disposed of accordingly.”

3. In compliance of the above order, reply dated 14.02.2025 on behalf of Anup Singh, District Development and Panchayat Officer-cum- Assistant Collector, 1st Grade, Fatehabad has been filed. The operative part of which reads as under:-

“3. That on 07.02.2025 site inspection was done in the presence of petitioner and old points/pillars were traced out by removing the interlocking paver blocks. Halka Kanoongo namely Ajit Singh verified the width of street with the help of inches Tape and found that most of encroachments were removed. The one gate pillar of House of Hanuman alias Man Singh Son of Ishwar was directed to remove and same was removed. On other four site's the width of Streets are found upto mark but some waste material was lying there. The photos after removal of pillar as well as other waste material are annexed as R-1 to R-5.”

4. In view of the above, order dated 30.05.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-11836-2024 has already been complied with. Learned counsel for the petitioner does not dispute the same.

5. Accordingly, the contempt is purged and rule is *discharged*.
