Learned counsel for the respondents relies upon a communication dated 17.02.2025, which has even been handed over to the learned counsel for petitioner and contends that the property in question stands restored in favour of the petitioner subject to clearance / revalidation of Demand Draft No. 572199, dated 02.04.2024, amounting to Rs.26,85,605/- and Demand Draft No. 572200, dated 08.04.2024, amounting to Rs. 1,18,187/- as well as the Audit. He further submits that the aforesaid exercise shall be subject to final outcome of the Review Application bearing ***RA-CW-65-2025***, titled "***Asha Rani and others Versus U.T., Chandigarh and others***", preferred at the instance of respondents-Department.
