1. This is a contempt petition filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 12.02.2024 passed in CWP-2964-2024.

2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the policy/notification qua grant of additional five percent marks under the socio-economic criteria has already been quashed by this Court. The order of this Court has been upheld by the Hon'ble Supreme Court as well. Therefore, there is no scope for the grant of additional five percent marks to the petitioner, as such. The entire result of selection process has been revised by excluding the marks of socio-economic criteria.

3. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.

4. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
