1. In the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, prayer is made for issuance of directions to the respondents concerned to consider and pass a speaking order in the representation dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-4) for considering her request for posting at Patiala, as per the existing policy.

2. Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that at this stage, he will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.1 to decide her representation dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-4), in a time bound manner.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Jyotnoor Kaur Sethi, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. She submits that in view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner, she has no objection if the representation is directed to be decided in a time bound manner.

5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the present writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to decide the representation dated 26.05.2025 (Annexure P-4), submitted by the petitioner, in accordance with law, within a period of 08 weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

6. Needless to say that the representation shall be decided after giving due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and by passing a detailed and reasoned speaking order.
