

dated 23.05.2022 (Annexure P-3) before the jurisdictional police authorities. He further submits that the present petition is totally misconceived. On 02.07.2022 respondent No.5 herself appeared before the Court concerned and suffered a statement that she may be allowed to withdraw the protection petition and the petitioner apprehends that the pregnancy of respondent No.5 would be terminated as the expected date of delivery of child was of 25.11.2022. The jurisdictional police authorities has failed to take any action on the detailed representation as such the disciplinary action is required to be taken against the official respondents for not properly investigating the matter and for not registering the FIR. He further submits that statement of petitioner was recorded which is available on record along with reply as Annexure R-1/T in which he categorically stated that he would not want any action on the application made by him.

4. Thus, keeping in view the statement given by the petitioner, no further direction is required to be passed by this Court and the present petition stands disposed of.
