1. The petitioners through instant petition under Section 528 read with Section 94 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 (for short 'BNSS') is seeking directions to Superintendent of Police to preserve call details of accused named in FIR No.0167 dated 27.11.2024 registered under Sections 305 and 331 (3) of BNSS at Police Station Civil Lines Bathinda, District Bathinda.

2. Mr. Gurvinder Singh Sidhu, Advocate submits that petitioner is a retired Police Officer. A theft took place at her residence. She disclosed name of accused. Police registered FIR against alleged accused. Investigating Officer filed cancellation report which was not accepted by trial Court. The Investigating Officer was directed to make further investigation. He also submits that grievance of the petitioner would be

addressed if jurisdictional Superintendent of Police is directed to preserve call details of the accused.

3. Concededly, Police filed cancellation report which was not accepted by the trial Court. The matter is under consideration before Investigating Officer. The Jurisdictional Magistrate is quite competent to address grievance of the petitioner who instead of approaching Magistrate has directly approached this Court.

4. ***Disposed of*** with liberty to petitioner to avail remedies as permissible by law.
