HARKESH MANUJA J. (Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Mr. Ajay Kumar Garg, Registrar, Deenbandhu Chhotu Ram University of Science & Technology, Murthal (Sonipat), Haryana, who is present in Court, submits that the arrears of salary to the petitioner for the post of Assistant w.e.f. 28.05.2019 till 06.09.2023 shall be released to him in terms of the Writ Court's order; within a period of 04 weeks from today.

2. In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the present petition.

3. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed as not pressed. Rule stands discharged.

4. However, in case the needful is not done within the afore-stated

period, as per undertaking, the petitioner would be at liberty to seek revival of the present contempt petition and in that eventuality, the erring concerned officer(s) would be liable to pay additional sum of Rs.50,000/- as costs from his/her own pocket in favour of the petitioner towards litigation expenses, immediately, i.e. on the first date of listing of revival application.
