The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondents No.1 to 5 to facilitate the Gram Panchayat Billi Braich, Post Office Daulatpur Dhadda, Tehsil Shahkot, District Jalandhar to carry out development works in the village and to ensure that respondent No.6 may not scuttle the development works of the Gram Panchayat by using his political influence.

2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners restrict their prayer as regards taking necessary steps by respondents No.3 and 4 for checking and improving the water logging issue in the Village Billi Braich, Post Office Daulatpur Dhadda, Tehsil Shahkot, District Jalandhar.

3. Learned State counsel submits that as on date, the water in the

village has already receded and the administration is taking active steps to check the water logging in the area and all possible steps would be taken in that regard.

4. Keeping in view the aforesaid stand taken by learned State counsel, no further orders are required to be passed in the present writ petition and the same is accordingly disposed of.
