**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to keep departmental proceedings in abeyance till the conclusion of criminal proceedings emanating out of FIR No.27 dated 10.12.2024, under Section 7 of Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988 as amended by PC (Amendment) Act, 2018 registered at Police Station Vigilance Bureau, Bathinda (Annexure P-1).

2. Mr. S.S. Brar, Advocate for the petitioner submits that respondents may be directed not to proceed with departmental proceeding till the filing of police report under Section 193 of BNSS.

3. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab concedes that this Court in similar cases has directed to keep the departmental proceedings in abeyance till the filing of police report. He further submits that all the witnesses in the departmental proceedings have been examined.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees with aforesaid statement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondent to keep departmental proceedings in abeyance till the date of filing of police report in aforesaid FIR.
