1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Sections 10 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 for initiating contempt proceedings against the respondents for disobedience of order dated 31.08.2020 passed by this court in CWP-12258-2017.

2. The counsel for the respondent No.2 has already placed on record copy of the affidavit filed by the respondent No.2, which is taken on record. The Registry is directed to scan the same and make it part of the soft copy of the case.

3. The counsel for respondent No.2, after going through the aforesaid affidavit, has submitted that the order, qua which contempt was asserted, has since been complied with by passing speaking order. No

further action is required in the matter. Accordingly, the present petition has been rendered as infructuous.

4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

5. However, if any grievance of any of the petitioners is left unaddressed, he/she will be at liberty to avail any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
