1. This petition has been filed under Section 528 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for the issuance of a direction upon the official respondents to take appropriate legal action upon the representations dated 10.12.2024 (Annexure P-8) and 29.8.2025 (Annexure P-11) moved by the petitioner against respondent No. 4, in accordance with law and within a time bound manner.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has filed the representations dated 10.12.2024 (Annexure P-8) and 29.8.2025 (Annexure P-11) before respondents No. 2 and 3, respectively raising his grievances as mentioned in the present petition but the same have not yet been considered and no action has been taken thereupon. He further submits that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied if, appropriate directions are issued to the respondents concerned to consider and decide the aforesaid representation filed by the petitioner and take necessary action thereupon.



3. Notice of motion to the official respondents at this stage only.
4. At the asking of the Court, Ms. Saumya Ahluwalia, Sr. DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3-State and submits that the needful will be done in due course. Let a complete set of the paper-book be supplied to her during the course of the day.
5. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of at this stage with a direction to respondents No. 2 and 3 to consider and decide the representations (Annexure P-8 and P-11) of the petitioner expeditiously and within a time bound manner, by passing a speaking order in accordance with law.
6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, also stands disposed of.
