Prayer in the present petition is for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondent for not complying the order dated 04.3.2021 (Annexure P-1) passed by a co-ordinate Bench of this Court in CWP-21271-2020 titled as “Manjit Singh vs. Union of India and others”, vide which the petition was disposed of with a direction “...to respondent No.4 to decide the compensation matter pending before him within four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Learned counsel for the respondent-State files the Compliance affidavit dated 08/17.5.2024 of Ms. Gurpreet Kaur Sapra, Commissioner-cum-Arbitrator, Jalandhar Division, Jalandhar. The same is taken on record. Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place.



Learned counsel for the State submits that necessary compliance has been made, while passing the Award dated 22.2.2023 (Annexure R-1 annexed with the Compliance affidavit) by the respondent-authority; thus, no cause survives in the present petition.
