The prayer in this appeal is for grant of anticipatory bail to the appellant in case FIR No.370 dated 28.06.2025 under Sections 115(2), 3(5), 333, 351(3), 305 BNS and 3(1)(R) SC/ST Act registered at P.S. Industrial Sector 29, Panipat.

The learned counsel for the appellant submits that in compliance of the order dated 31.07.2025, the appellant has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from DSP Sudesh Kumar admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the appellant is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 31.07.2025 is made absolute. However, the appellant shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.
