The petitioners allege violation of the order dated 03.07.2018 passed in CWP-13772-2017, vide which petition was disposed of to consider case of the petitioners, in accordance with law.

As per affidavit of ADC, Jind, the petitioners have participated in the selection process and were found eligible, but they could not qualify in the merit, as last selected person has secured 76 marks, whereas the petitioners have secured less than 76 marks.

In view of the above, present petition is rendered as infructuous.
