It is the contention of learned counsel for the respondents that after the passing of the order dated 15.12.2008, although an application was submitted before the Estate Officer by the petitioners within the time stipulated but no Mega Lok Adalat was held on 20.12.2008 or 21.12.2008 nor has any Mega Lok Adalat held after the said date. He further states that there is no proposal for holding a Lok Adalat, where the claim of the petitioners could be settled.

Counsel for the petitioners is not present nor was he present on 08.12.2017, when the case was taken up for hearing. It appears that the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the matter any further.

The contempt petition is, therefore, dismissed for non-prosecution.

Rule issued to the respondents stands discharged.
