By way of present petition filed under Section 528 of BNSS, 2023, petitioners seek quashing of FIR (Annexure P-1) and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom. Details of the FIR are as follows:

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have sought quashing of the instant FIR (Annexure P-1) on the ground that as per the allegations levelled therein, the petitioners are alleged to have entered into agreement qua fraudulent sale of land. It is alleged in the FIR that the land belong to *Gurudwara Sahib*. He, by referring to the documents annexed with the petition claims that the land did not belong to *Gurudwara Sahib* and submits that the investigation is still going on. He contends that

the continuation of the instant FIR is nothing but abuse of process of law. Hence, the present petition.

3. Notice of motion.

4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Praveen Bhadu, AAG, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that the matter is still under investigation and the petitioners have not joined the investigation and as and when they join the investigation, they can produce the documents which are under their custody to show that the land in question did not belong to *Gurudwara Sahib*, which will be considered by the investigating agency in accordance with law.

5. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners has sought withdrawal of the present petition at this stage with liberty to take up all the pleas and produce the relevant documents before the investigating agency for being considered in accordance with law.

6. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

7. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
