The petition has been filed seeking a writ of *certiorari* quashing the order dated 05.04.2001, Annexure P-7, whereby the petitioner has been declined the benefit of selection grade since he has not completed eighteen years of service before 01.01.1986, as required under government letter dated 28.06.1991.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that the petitioner joined service as JBT teacher on *ad hoc* basis with effect from 09.09.1967, and was regularised with effect from 08.04.1969. Accordingly, he completed eighteen years of service from the date of initial appointment on 09.09.1985 which entitled him to grant of selection grade. He, however, could not refer to any rule or instructions to establish his entitlement. It is not his case either that the aforesaid instructions permit grant of the grade by counting *ad hoc* service.
