The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing official respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for reversion/demotion from the post of Assistant Revenue Accountant (ARA) to the post of Upper Division Clerk (UDC).

2. Mr. Charanpreet Singh, Advocate has appeared in pursuance of the advance notice of the instant petition, having been sent to the respondents-PSPCL.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the petitioner, submits that the petitioner would be satisfied, if the representation dated 29.01.2025 (Annexure P-4) made by him to respondent No.2-Chief Financial Officer, Punjab State Power Corporation Limited, Patiala, is directed to be decided expeditiously.
