1. The petitioner has filed the instant petition under Section 482 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.32 dated 17.05.2025 registered under Sections 85, 115(2) & 316(2) of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 at Police Station Women Cell, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. Status report by way of an affidavit of Sh. Jaswinder Singh, PPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police (Crime Against Women & Children), Amritsar City, on behalf of the respondent-State, filed in the Registry is taken on record.

3. Vide order dated 22.07.2025, while granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, on request made by learned counsel for the parties, the matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court to explore the possibility of amicable settlement between the parties.

4. As per report dated 01.09.2025 received from the Mediator, despite best efforts, the parties could not reach at any amicable settlement.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 22.07.2025 passed by this Court, the petitioner has appeared before the Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

6. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Onkar Singh, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation.

7. In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim relief granted to the petitioner vide order dated 22.07.2025 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) of Cr.P.C./482(2) of BNSS, 2023.
