**RAJESH BHARDWAJ, J.(ORAL)**

1. Present petition has been filed praying for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.260, dated 29.09.2021, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Sector 39, Chandigarh.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner fairly submits that he does not want to press this petition and the same may be dismissed as such. However, he prays that the petitioner may be granted liberty to surrender and file an appropriate application for bail before the trial Court with direction to learned trial Court to decide his bail application in a time bound manner.
3. Allowed as prayed for.
4. Petition is dismissed as not pressed with liberty aforesaid. In case the petitioner surrenders and applies for regular bail before the
