**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J (ORAL)**

1. Through instant application under Section 11 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (for short '1996 Act'), the applicant is seeking appointment of an Arbitrator.
2. The parties entered into arbitration agreement dated 03.01.2022. A dispute erupted between the parties. The applicant served notice upon respondent seeking resolution of dispute through arbitral tribunal but to no avail.
3. The execution of arbitration agreement and service of notice invoking arbitration clause is not disputed.
4. Mr. Aman Dhir, DAG, Punjab expressed his inability to controvert execution of arbitration agreement and service of notice.
5. Conditions to invoke power conferred by Section 11(6) of 1996 Act stand satisfied, thus, I hereby appoint a sole Arbitrator to adjudicate the dispute between the parties.

Mrs. Shyama Dogra, Former Member (Judicial), Central Administrative Tribunal, residing at #Flat No.2168/A, 1st Floor, Block-7, Chandigarh Housing Board Flats, Sector 63, Chandigarh- 160047, Mobile Nos.9459288219, 9418696233 is hereby appointed as a Sole Arbitrator to adjudicate the dispute between the parties, subject to compliance of statutory requirements. The learned Arbitrator is requested to comply with mandate of Section 12 of 1996 Act before proceeding further.

7. Parties are directed to appear before the learned Arbitrator on date, time and place to be fixed by the Arbitrator at her convenience.

8. The Arbitrator shall be paid fee in accordance with the Fourth Schedule of the 1996 Act, as amended.

9. The Arbitrator is requested to complete the proceedings as per time limit specified under Section 29-A of the 1996 Act.

10. Needless to mention, parties would be at liberty to raise all the claims/defences/counter claims/pleas before the Arbitrator. Any observation made hereinabove will not be binding on the learned Arbitrator.

12. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
