1. Through the instant petition, cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a prayer is made for issuance of a mandamus, directing the respondents No.2 to 4, to perform their imperative corresponding duty to register an FIR, and investigate the complaints against the respondents No.5 to 7, in pursuance to enquiry reports/recommendations dated 12.02.2021 and 01.07.2021 (Annexures P-2 and P-3), submitted by a Senior Police Officer, i.e. DSP, Yamuna Nagar-3 (respondent No.4).

2. Learned counsel for the State, informs this Court, that the prayer made in the instant petition has already been rendered infructuous, as the FIR has already been registered, and even after conclusion of the investigation, a cancellation report stands presented on dated 18.02.2023, before the learned Illaqa Magistrate concerned.
