**JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)**

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent to consider her claim of re-fixing seniority/merit list by adding marks obtained by her in supplementary exam.
2. The petitioner joined Haryana Police Force as Constable on 15.04.2008. She participated in batch No.61 of Lower School Course on the basis of B-1 test cleared by her. The petitioner fell ill, thus, could not take part in last paper of said course.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that respondent has counted marks of supplementary exam in the case of similarly situated employees, however, claim of petitioner has not been acceded to.
4. On being confronted with order dated 29.07.2022 passed by
