**VIKRAM AGGARWAL, J. (ORAL)**

The instant contempt petition has been instituted alleging disobedience of order dated 28.05.2025, passed in CWP-15463-2025 (Annexure P-1), vide which a direction had been issued to respondent No.4 – Estate Officer, Haryana Shaheri Vikas Pradhikaran, Faridabad, Haryana, to consider the pending representation dated 05.05.2025 moved by the petitioner and to pass an appropriate reasoned order in accordance with law, within a period of 10 weeks.

2. Reply on behalf of the respondents by way of affidavit of Estate Officer-II, HSVP, Faridabad, has been filed in Court today, which is taken on record.

3. With reference to the reply, learned State counsel submits that in compliance of order dated 28.05.2025, a speaking order dated 28.08.2025 (Annexure R-1) has been passed by the concerned authority.



4. In response, learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that no grievance now subsists and that the petitioner, if so advised, shall avail all such other remedies as shall be admissible in law against the said speaking order.

5. In view of the statement given by learned counsel for the petitioner, the instant contempt petition is disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Rule stands discharged.

7. Pending applications, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
