1. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that upon a petition preferred by the petitioner while invoking Section 528 of BNSS, on the same set of facts, the petitioner has been granted liberty to avail his alternate remedy. The order dated 10.07.2025 passed in CRM-M-33524-2025 is extracted as under:-

*“The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of BNSS with a prayer to issue directions to the official respondents to register an FIR and to take action against respondents No.4 to 6 on the basis of representation dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure P-3), submitted by the petitioner.*

*On an advance notice, Mr. Mansih Bansal, Public Prosecutor has put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and submitted that a representation dated 19.05.2025 (Annexure P-3) was received and after holding an enquiry, it was found that there is no substance in the complaint/representation submitted by the petitioner and the matter has been closed.*



*In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondent- UT Chandigarh, no further directions are required to be issued and the present petition stands disposed of.*

*Needless to observe that the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail his alternative remedy, if any, in accordance with law.”*

2. In such circumstances, learned counsel seeks to withdraw the present petition, however, seeks to avail his remedy in accordance with law.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

Rule stands discharged.
