1. This is a contempt petition filed under Sections 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, for punishing the respondent for disobeying the order dated 14.11.2022 passed in LPA-161-2017.
2. Counsel for the respondent submits that the order dated 14.11.2022 passed in LPA-161-2017 has been complied with and speaking order dated 14.03.2024 has been passed. Copy of the order dated 14.03.2024 produced by the counsel for the respondent in the Court today, is taken on record. Registry is directed to scan and tag it at an appropriate place.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has not even disputed the aforesaid fact.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is rendered infructuous and dismissed, as such.
5. However, if any grievance of the petitioner is left unredressed, he would be at liberty to raise the same in any other alternate remedy, but in accordance with law.
