1. Petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C., for quashing of the FIR No.306, dated 10.11.2020, under Sections 336, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station Sadar, District Amritsar(Annexure P-1) and all the consequential proceedings arising therefrom on the basis of compromise dated 15.04.2023 (Annexure P-2).

2. At the outset, learned State counsel appearing on advance notice, submits that out of total four accused in the case, three accused have already been declared proclaimed offenders and the instant petition has been filed by only one accused(petitioner). He further submits that in view of the judgment passed by the Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in **Rakesh Das v. State of Haryana and another [CRM-M-48043-2023 (O&M)] (Decided on : 12.11.2024) : Law Finder Doc Id # 2663704**, partial quashing is not permissible.

3. In view of the above, present petition is dismissed with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh and comprehensive petition by impleading all the necessary parties i.e. accused and the complainant(s)/victim(s).

4. Disposed of, in view of the above said terms.
