DEEPAK GUPTA, J. (ORAL)

1. As per the report received from the Registry, the sole appellant has expired. Out of 4 respondents, 3 of them namely respondents No.1, 3 & 4 have died. Respondent No.2 has been duly served.
2. Learned counsel for the appellant submits that none of the LR's of the appellant has contacted him till date. Counsel for the respondents has also submitted that none of the surviving respondents; or the LR's of the deceased respondents have ever contacted him till date.
3. Apart from the above, it is noticed that it was a suit for permanent injunction, the judgment of which has been assailed before this Court.
4. It is highly doubtful that even the cause of action is still surviving. Having noticed the aforesaid circumstances, the present appeal is hereby disposed of with liberty to get it revived, in case any cause of action still survives.
