**ALOK JAIN, J. (Oral)**

1. The present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.85 dated 05.03.2022, under Sections 302, 34/114 of IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 354 of IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Chandhut, District Palwal, Haryana.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, yet again, prays for an adjournment. Similar was the position on the last three occasions.
3. The petitioner is the main accused who had fired from the weapon of his father which resulted into death of petitioner's wife.
4. Learned State counsel has filed the custody certificate which is taken on record. She submits that 19 out of 23 prosecution witnesses have already been examined and the trial is at the fag end.
5. In light of the above, the petitioner is not entitled to the concession of regular bail.
6. Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
