**SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (ORAL)**

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 08.01.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-31802-2024.

2. Notice of motion.

3. On asking of the Court, Mr. Animesh Sharma, Addl. A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

4. This Court had issued the following directions in CWP-31802-2024, vide its order dated 08.01.2025:-

*“3. On the asking of the Court, Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and submits that in case, the legal notice dated dated 23.12.2023 (Annexure P-2) has been received in the*

*office of the concerned authorities and the same is still pending consideration with the authorities concerned, the same will be decided by the competent authority within a period of eight weeks from the date of the receipt of certified copy of this order by passing an appropriate speaking order.*

*4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.”*

5. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that in compliance of the order dated 08.01.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-31802-2024, legal notice dated 23.12.2023 has been decided by the respondent by passing a speaking order dated 29.09.2025. A copy thereof has been placed on record as well as supplied to the learned counsel for the petitioner, who does not dispute the same.

6. In view of the above, since order dated 08.01.2025 passed by this Court in CWP-31802-2024, has already been complied with, therefore, the present contempt is purged and rule stands discharged.

7. Needless to say that the petitioner is at liberty to avail remedy as is available to him in accordance with law to challenge the speaking order dated 29.09.2025 passed by the respondent.

8. Pending application(s), if any, also stand disposed of.
