The present contempt proceedings have been sought to be initiated on account of alleged willful non-compliance of interim order dated 13.07.1994 passed in CWP-9088-1994 whereby, the parties were directed to maintain status quo with regard to possession of the land in dispute.

It has been averred that despite respondent being made aware of the aforesaid interim order, the planted Shisham Trees on the land thereby, willfully disobeying the afore-stated interim order.

A perusal of the record shows that even notice of motion was never issued by this Court and the matter was always adjourned on the request made by learned counsel for the petitioner. Further Civil Writ Petition bearing No.9088 of 1994 came to be disposed of by this Court vide decision dated 03.03.2015 in terms of Full Bench decision of this Court in "***Jai Singh and Ors. Vs. State of Haryana and Ors., 2003(2) RCR (Civil) 578***"

In such circumstances, no further orders are required to be passed as even *prima facie* case is not made out against the respondents especially, when no interference to possession has been alleged.

The present petition is thus, disposed of.
