1. The present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.125 dated 11.08.2024, under Sections 64 (2) (K), 65 (2) of BNS, 2023 and Sections 4 and 6 of the POCSO Act, 2012, registered at Police Station City South, District Moga.

2. Custody certificate filed by the learned State counsel is taken on record.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the entire allegations levelled against the petitioner in the FIR are false and the petitioner has been unnecessarily entangled. Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon the medical report of the prosecutrix and emphasizes that there was no injury caused to the prosecutrix and also relies upon the

medical report of the petitioner which says that there was no external injury or deformity on external genitalia.

4. *Per contra*, learned State counsel has submitted that the charges have been framed and there are 20 prosecution witnesses, out of which one has been examined and the trial is progressing at a good pace. Learned State counsel further submits that the prosecutrix is a mentally retarded girl of 11 years and any concession granted to the petitioner would adversely affect the prosecutrix and her family. Learned State counsel also submits that gravity of offence committed by the petitioner does not entitle him for concession of bail.

5. Heard the learned counsel for the parties at length.

6. Considering the submissions made by the learned State counsel, this Court does not find it a case where the petitioner should be granted any concession of bail.

7. Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
