The present petition has been filed under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for issuance of directions to respondents No.3 & 4 to not harass the petitioner and visit her house without associating two independent inhabitants of the locality and lady official as the petitioner is a widow and senior citizen.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on 04.04.2025 respondent No.5 in civil dress and respondent No.6 in police uniform and two other persons in civil dress claiming themselves to be officials of CIA staff, Jalandhar visited the house of the petitioner at around 05:00 P.M. and remained therein upto 11:30 P.M. of the night and asked whereabouts of one Paramjit Singh. The petitioner neither had any knowledge regarding the same nor any connection with one Paramjit Singh and so conveyed the same to the stated officials. Thereafter, respondents No.5 & 6 terrorized the petitioner and also her phone was taken into possession by them and did not allow her to contact anybody and asked her to not disclose to anyone regarding their visit. Thereafter, on 05.04.2025 at around 02:30 P.M. and on 13.04.2025 at around 06:30 A.M., respondent No.6 along with other officials of CIA staff, Jalandhar again visited the house of the petitioner and asked about said Paramjit Singh and left the house of the petitioner at around 03:30 P.M. and 07:30 P.M., respectively. Thereafter, the petitioner has moved a representation dated



17.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) for seeking protection of her life and liberty.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 17.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to the official respondents only.

Mr. Sandeep Kumar, DAG, Punjab, puts in appearance and accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State and copy of the petition has been supplied in the Court.

Keeping in view the prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 17.04.2025 (Annexure P-3) submitted by the petitioner and take appropriate steps including grant of any protection to the petitioner in view of the apprehension, if any, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law.
