**HARPREET SINGH BRAR, J. (ORAL)**

1. Present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India *inter alia* for issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* seeking quashing the letter dated 07.07.2023 (Annexure P-3) whereby the claim of the petitioner for counting of work charge service rendered by him towards the pensionary benefits has been denied by respondent no. 3.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that the grievance raised by the petitioner in the present petition has substantially been redressed. However, the only dispute is with regard to interest on the delayed payment of retiral benefits.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent-Corporation submits that claim of the petitioner has been examined in light of the applicable instructions and all admissible benefits have been paid to the petitioner. He has placed on record a copy of Revised Pay order dated 03.12.2024 and submits that all claims raised by the petitioner have been substantially redressed.

4. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof. He seeks liberty to file a fresh representation claiming interest on the delayed payment.

5. In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh representation within a period of four weeks and the same shall be decided by respondent-Corporation by affording an opportunity of hearing and by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within three months thereafter.

6. Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall be disposed of.
