JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondents to count daily wages/work charge service for the purpose of retiral benefits.

2. Mr. Sandeep Thakan, counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner is at par with Suresh Kumar and this Court vide order dated 23.01.2024 passed in *Civil Writ Petition No.991 of 2024* titled as '*Suresh Kumar Vs. Managing Director, UHBVNL and others*' had directed the respondent to consider and decide his Legal Notice by passing of speaking order.

3. Mr. Raman Sharma, Addl. AG, Haryana and Mr. Prince Singh, Advocate who on advance notice are present in Court, submit that respondent-department has not received any notice from the petitioner.

4. Be that as it may, the respondents are directed to consider instant petition as petitioner's representation and pass an appropriate order in terms of order dated 23.01.2024 passed by this Court in *Suresh Kumar (supra)*. It is made clear that petitioner shall not be entitled to interest on arrears, if any.
