The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to regularise the petitioner's services in view of Haryana Government Notification, dated 18.06.2014, Annexure P-3, with all consequential benefits.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that at this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case he is permitted to make a fresh representation before the respondents raising the grievance as has been raised in this petition, and the same may be ordered to be decided within a specified period

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr. Rohit Arya, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and submits that in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner within two weeks from today, the same will be decided by respondent no.2/Director, Higher Education Department, by passing a speaking order thereupon in accordance with law, within a period of three months of receiving the representation.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.

6. Ordered accordingly.

7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
